



LIFE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AND SELECTION PROCESS:

To be eligible for consideration for a LIFE scholarship, students must meet the following **4** criteria:

1. Be Lebanese or of Lebanese descent

The applicant will have to demonstrate that s/he holds Lebanese nationality or have at least 1 parent or 2 grandparents who have the Lebanese nationality

2. Demonstrate interest in pursuing a career in Finance

The applicant will have to demonstrate that s/he is passionate about finance and is motivated to continue to study and work in the field

3. Be in financial need

LIFE will assess the financial needs based on the financial information provided by the candidates with relevant documents where appropriate. When available we rely on the financial aid offices of pre-selected universities to assess whether a student has a genuine financial need, based on their internal policies and criteria

4. Achieve and maintain academic excellence (at or above 80th percentile)

LIFE will assess the academic excellence of candidates based on high school and/or universities official transcript. We also rely on the financial aid offices of respective schools/universities to assess academic excellence. Applicants have to achieve 80th percentile in their high school or university studies to be eligible for consideration. Scholarship recipients will also be required to maintain or exceed that level to continue to be eligible to receive the scholarship in subsequent years

DISBURSEMENT PROCESS

- The scholarship award amounts up to US\$12,000 per year
- Scholarships will be paid directly to universities and will cover only tuition fees

SCHOLARSHIP FOLLOW-UP

Once the scholarship is granted, LIFE assigns a mentor to each scholarship recipient from among the ranks of our global membership not only to mentor but also to act as a source of support and assistance in applying for internships and/or permanent employment
